- Board of Governors includes representatives from: Senate, Alumni, Community, Lieutenant-Governor in Council, Teaching and Non-Teaching Staff, Graduate and Undergraduate Students, and Divinity College.
- Senate includes representatives from: Board of Governors, Alumni, Teaching Staff, Divinity College, and Graduate and Undergraduate Students.
- The Chancellor is omitted since the President and Vice-Chancellor is designated the Chief Executive Officer by Bill Pr7, An Act Respecting McMaster University, passed by the Ontario Legislature on April 13, 1976.

- (1) Decanal responsibilities which report through the Office of the Provost and Vice-President (Academic).
- (2) Master of Health Management is a joint program between the Faculty of Health Sciences and the DeGroot School of Business.
- (3) BHSc - MSc in Biomedical Discovery and Commercialization (BDC) is a joint program between the Faculty of Health Sciences and the DeGroot School of Business.
- (4) Integrated Biomedical Engineering and Health Sciences (IBEHS) program reports jointly to the Faculty of Engineering and to the Faculty of Health Sciences.
- (5) The Michael G DeGroot Health Leadership Academy is a joint program between the DeGroot School of Business and the Faculty of Health Sciences.
- (6) MSc in eHealth is an interdisciplinary program with the DeGroot School of Business, the Faculty of Engineering, and the Faculty of Health Sciences. The program reports academically and administratively to the DeGroot School of Business.
- (7) Global Health is an interdisciplinary program with the DeGroot School of Business, the Faculty of Social Sciences, and the Faculty of Health Sciences. The program reports academically and administratively to the Faculty of Health Sciences.
- (8) The School of Biomedical Engineering reports academically to the Faculty of Engineering and the Faculty of Health Sciences but administratively to the Faculty of Engineering.
- (9) The Centre for Health Economics and Policy Analysis (CHEPA) reports jointly to the Faculty of Health Sciences and the Faculty of Social Sciences.
- (10) The Ombudsperson reports to the President and Vice-Chancellor and to the President of the McMaster Students' Union (MSU).
- (11) The Associate Vice-President and Chief Technology Officer reports jointly to the Provost and Vice-President (Academic) and to the Vice-President (Operations and Finance).
- (12) The Chief Internal Auditor reports administratively to the Vice-President (Operations and Finance) and functionally to the Board of Governors through the Audit and Risk Committee.
- (13) Housing and Conference Services reports jointly to the Vice-President (Operations and Finance) and to the Associate Vice-President (Students and Learning) and Dean of Students.
- (14) Computational Science and Engineering reports academically to the Faculty of Science and the Faculty of Engineering but administratively to the Faculty of Science.
- (15) The School of Earth, Environment and Society and the Department of Psychology, Neuroscience and Behaviour report academically to the Faculties of Science and Social Sciences, but administratively to the Faculty of Science.
- (16) Neuroscience is a joint program between the Faculty of Health Sciences and the Faculty of Science.
- (17) Chemical Biology is a joint program between the Faculty of Science and the Faculty of Health Sciences.
- (18) Health Policy PhD Program is a joint program between the DeGroot School of Business, the Faculty of Social Sciences, and the Faculty of Health Sciences.
- (19) Astrobiology reports academically to the Faculty of Science and the Faculty of Health Sciences, but administratively to the Faculty of Science.
- (20) BHSc in Integrated Humanities and Rehabilitation is a joint program between the Faculty of Health Sciences and the Faculty of Humanities.
- (21) Bio-Interfaces Institute formally reports to the Faculty of Engineering but is co-directed by the Faculty of Engineering and the Faculty of Science.
